What a year it has been, we finally, received the approval from the City of Brampton on Aug 11th to begin playing, as long as we followed the protocol set down by the City, wearing a mask, social distance and using the sanitizer supplied by the City, each division must stay in their own bubble and not socializing with other divisions, one person to keep the scoring and marking the sheets. We marked the walkways with arrows, so you walked in one direction, and the players at the other end walked on the other side, maintaining the proper 6 ft. distance.

Over the 8 weeks of play, we never kept track of wins and loss, only the personal averages of

the 80 out of 141 members, that decided to play, we average around 50 – 60 players a night, the weather overall was perfect for pitching shoes, no rainouts.

Our club is built on socializing with all players, so it was a difficult to change our habits that we have promoted over the past 42 years, but we did it and so far, we have had no reports of anyone testing positive of COVID -19.



We finished playing for this year on September 29th, there was no fee charge for this year, no banquet, no player of the week award, not weekly draw, no water or pop available, no weekly newspaper, let's hope that we can resume normal play next year on May 4, 2021, I am sure if we all do our part we can beat this Covid-19.

Gary Branning one of our executive members is working on building a new website, and will be ready the first of January, I can't wait to see the new look.

We were saddened to hear of the passing of **Moe McGreggor**, over the years he welcomed our club to Hamilton to enjoy their facility, we will miss seeing him behind the bar, and serving up barbeque hamburgers. He will be missed by all horseshoe players, but Never Forgotten.
