2. Shovels, brooms, rakes and watering cans for pit maintenance.
3. Paint for stakes and for painting the stakes after the completion of each shift.
4. Scoreboards and chairs for the scorekeepers in the centre of each court.
5. Bulletin board for posting game results.
6. Dry place to set up computer with electrical outlets.
7. Tables to set up Horseshoe Ontario Related Items.
8. Place to lock up computer and Horseshoe ON Games Related Items at night.
9. Added prize money (except deposit) in cash by Friday afternoon.
10. Supply food and bar.
11. Supply list of accommodations (hotels, camping etc.) in your area.
12. Complete directions to your club.
13. Portable pits must be level (preferably on pavement) with non-slip walkways.

Optional (Host Club)

- Opening Ceremony
- Gift bags or pins for all Players
- Media coverage (newspaper/TV etc.)
- Banquet & Entertainment



Horseshoe Ontario will be required to supply:

1. Computer and paper and post results
2. Score sheets.
3. Check memberships, name shirts and hand out individual round robin sheets.
4. Crests for winners of each class.
5. Judges and equipment.
6. Have photographs taken.
7. Assist the Host Club with media coverage.

Thank you to all of those who participated in the recent voting on the rule change that was proposed at the 2022 World Tournament Convention. As was mentioned, the delegates voted to bring this to the body of the delegates to make sure that the voice of ALL delegates was heard on this important rule proposal.

The proposal that was sent:

The rule as it currently reads:

Rule 1 - Pitching Divisions

Section F - Elder Men (become eligible to pitch in the Elders Division upon purchase of an NHPA card dated for the calendar year that they become seventy (70) years old).

Proposed change:

Rule 1 - Pitching Divisions

Section F - Elder Men (become eligible to pitch in the Elders Division upon purchase of an NHPA card dated for the calendar year that they become sixty-five (65) years old).

Results:

With 98 delegates casting their vote, the proposed change passed with a score of 73 yes votes and 25 no votes. The proposal required a 60% approval to pass. With 74.5% approval, the vote passed and will be effective October 1st 2022.

We encourage everyone to reach out to their friends and neighbors and encourage them to plan their retirement with us on the local horse-shoe pits!
